2009 H1N1 Flu Clinic

Sussex County's first 2009 H1N1 Flu (Swine Flu) Clinic will be held on
Sunday, November 1, 2009 at
Sussex County Community College
One College Hill
Newton, NJ 07860
9am - 1pm and 2pm - 6pm

Due to the limited initial supply of vaccine, the first clinic will be for healthy children between the ages of 2 and 24, and will only offer the 2009 H1N1 nasal spray flu vaccine.

Anyone listed in the following groups should **NOT** get the 2009 H1N1 nasal spray flu vaccine and should contact their health care provider: pregnant women; anyone under 2 or over 49 years old; anyone with asthma or active wheezing; children or adolescents on long-term aspirin treatment; someone with a serious allergy to eggs; anyone with a weakened immune system; anyone with a long-term health problem such as diabetes; heart, lung, liver, or kidney disease; anyone with certain muscle or nerve disorders; a life-threatening allergic reaction after a dose of seasonal flu vaccine; or history of Guillain-Barré syndrome.

An appointment is necessary to attend in the 2009 H1N1 flu vaccine clinic.

Additional clinics have been scheduled to provide ALL residents with an opportunity to receive a 2009 H1N1 flu vaccination. You can also contact your health care provider to determine the availability of the 2009 H1N1 flu vaccine through their office.

The **NEXT PRIORITY GROUPS** recommended to receive the 2009 H1N1 influenza vaccine include:

- Pregnant women
- Household contacts and caregivers for children younger than 6 months of age
- Healthcare and emergency medical services personnel
- All people from 6 months through 24 years of age
- Persons aged 25 through 64 years who have health conditions associated with higher risk of medical complications from influenza.

How to prepare for the 2009 H1N1 Flu Clinic:

- Talk to your doctor to determine if you are eligible to receive a 2009 H1N1 Flu Vaccine.
- Visit the Sussex County website, at www.sussex.nj.us/flu to:
 - (1) Make a **required** appointment by following the directions posted online.
 - (2) Download and complete 2009 H1N1 flu vaccine consent forms to bring with you to flu clinic.
 - (3) Call 973-579-0570, for assistance.
