1. Healthy children and young adults between the ages of 2 and 24
2. Healthy people between 25-49 years old who are:
  - Healthcare/emergency medical services personnel
  - Household contacts/caregivers for children younger than 6 months of age

**Afternoon clinic will offer**  
**ONLY 2009 H1N1 injectable flu vaccine**  
**1 pm - 4 pm for these priority groups:**

- Pregnant women
- All children and young adults between 6 months through 24 months of age
- Household contacts and are responsible for children younger than 6 months of age
- Healthcare and emergency medical services personnel
- People 25 through 64 years of age who have underlying health conditions

The 2009 H1N1 injectable flu vaccine is **NOT** recommended for people with severe allergy to eggs, or to any other substance in the vaccine; anyone who has had a life-threatening allergic reaction after a dose of seasonal flu vaccine; or infants younger than 6 months of age. If you have underlying health conditions or questions about your personal health, please contact your health care provider to discuss your concerns about the 2009 H1N1 Flu Vaccine.
