Dear Lenape Families,

On behalf of the administration, faculty, and staff, I want to welcome you to the Lenape Valley 2020-2021 school-year. This year, we will reopen under the extraordinary circumstances of the COVID-19 crisis. Our reopening committee was composed of several persons, both employees and members of the community, guided by direction from the State of New Jersey, we have laid groundwork for how we will proceed until we can return to normal operations. There will be: limitations to on-campus instruction, busing, and extracurricular activities, observing social distancing considerations and cleaning protocols. There is a great deal of important information on the following pages. Please read everything carefully.

Most importantly, there is crucial information we need from every family by August 1, 2020.

As we plan for the opening of the school, we need your declaration that:

<p>You will either . . .</p> <p>. . . send your child to be instructed in all classes on-campus during their assigned cohort.</p> <p>Or</p> <p>. . . keep them home to participate in all classes remotely. *</p> <p>* This decision will be for the entire First Marking Period. Families who wish to change their child's status can do so at the Second Marking Period.</p>
<p>Your child will . . .</p> <p>. . . arrive at and depart school by school-provided busing.</p> <p>Or</p> <p>. . . not be using any school transportation.</p>

As part of our effort to limit exposure and provide safe social distancing in our classrooms, halls and on busses, the student body has been split into two cohorts, A (students whose last names start with A through L) and B (students whose last names start with M through Z), who will be on campus at different times. When one group is at the school, the other group will participate in classes online. The school-day will begin at 7:20 a.m. and will end at 11:35 a.m. Our faculty will be available to assist students remotely from 12:30 p.m. until 2:20 p.m. A schedule of four one-hour classes for each day has been created. A calendar with a schedule of classes is provided in this packet.

On Wednesday, August 26, 2020 school officially begins. Buses will pick up students of Cohort A at their assigned locations and times, arriving at Lenape Valley at 7:20 a.m. Upon arrival to school all students will report to their Period One class. Students in Cohort B will participate remotely. Students will be dismissed at 11:35 a.m. On Thursday, August 27, 2020, buses will pick up students of Cohort B at their assigned locations and times, arriving at Lenape Valley at 7:20 a.m. Upon arrival to school all students will report to their Period One class. Students in Cohort A will participate remotely. Students will be dismissed at 11:35 a.m. This rotation between Cohorts A and B will continue until we can resume normal operations.

In mid-August, a separate mailing with your bus route number and pick up time will be sent.

**GENERAL PROVISIONS:**

All persons within the school will be required to wear masks at all times. Though we have taken precautions to limit the number of people in the building, some classrooms may contain twenty or more students where six feet of distance between persons is impossible.

All persons entering the school will have their temperature taken by a scanner. Anyone who registers at 100.4 degrees or more will be evaluated by our nurse. Students and employees whom the nurse confirms a 100.4 degree temperature or higher will be sent home.

All students and employees are required to complete a COVID questionnaire, daily. A nightly email will be sent via Genesis Parent Portal containing the daily questionnaire to be submitted electronically (a copy of it is attached) before entering the school..

There will be no late busing. Students who participate in activities after the 11:35 a.m. dismissal must arrange for transportation home.

For our free/reduced breakfast and lunch students (or those who wish to purchase) breakfast will be eaten in classrooms and bagged lunches will be provided prior to dismissal.

There will be no large student assemblies, and all field trips are cancelled until further notice.

No guests or visitors will be allowed in the building; conferences will take place virtually.

Upon entering the school, students will report directly to their first class of the day. Lockers will be inaccessible until we can resume normal operations.


One lavatory for each sex will be open per floor, and a monitor will be present to restrict their use to one student at a time.

The flow of traffic into and within the building will be one-directional, guided by queues, arrows, and markings on the floor.

Students who have committed to remote instruction will be permitted to participate in extracurricular activities.

*Parents who have reservations about their child's participation in on-campus education are advised to have their child participate remotely from home.*
