Dear Lenape Valley Students and Families,

As a result of the COVID-19 crisis, Lenape Valley will receive a special grant with which we will be able to offer summer enrichment courses for our students. These courses are NOT summer school for credit. Rather, they would be extended learning for classes our students had in this school year, at no cost to families.

At this time, we are able to offer these classes in every subject area, however we will only be able to hold sessions based on student and parent interest. Classes would take place on campus, during our summer hours, Monday through Thursday, 8:00 am to 3:00 pm, in July (possibly in to August based on the level of interest), for a total of ten hours per course. There would be no bussing for participating students; they will need to have their own transportation to and from campus.

We will send all of our families a survey shortly to gauge interest and to formulate a schedule of offerings.

Students who have either failed classes or may be in danger of failing at the end of the year, I strongly encourage to contact their guidance counselors as soon as possible and make the necessary arrangements to attend summer school.
