Dear Lenape Families,

Every year, many students need the opportunity of summer school to get back on track in order to graduate with their class. Lenape Valley does offer courses in: English, mathematics, science, the social studies, and Spanish I. Students who would benefit from summer school and their families will be contacted by a guidance counselor.

To retrieve credit for a failed, five-credit class, students must attend a summer session for SIXTY HOURS and must achieve a passing grade. The passing grade and recovered credits for the summer school course will be recorded students' on transcripts.

Below are the basic guidelines for summer school. A more detailed description can be found on the Guidance Department's page of our website.

Our program has a \$25 registration fee, and the tuition is \$300 per course.

Students may take no more than two courses.

For families who choose a summer school program other than Lenape Valley's own, in order to receive credit, students must enroll in an on-campus course that is instructed by a teacher. At-home online summer school programs will not be accepted for credit retrieval.

Time lost to absenteeism or tardiness must be made up; students are required to have sixty hours.

Any summer school student who has to be disciplined by the administration will be dismissed from the program without any refund whatsoever.

The deadline for summer school registration is June 19, 2017.
