Dear Students, Families, and Staff,

This morning the NJDOE testing calendar was sent out to the community, which included a statement regarding a two-hour delayed opening. We are following our schedule for the fall NJ Start Strong tests that was published on September 15, which calls for a shorter delay for non-testing students. The text of that letter is below (and on our website), along with the schedule for our testing days. We apologize for any confusion.

Students will take the NJ Start Strong Assessments this fall. These are a diagnostic series, which will provide our school immediate feedback to aid this year's instruction.

- All students in ninth and tenth grade will take the English examination.
- All students in ninth and twelfth grade will take the science examination.
- All students in Algebra 1, Algebra 2, or Geometry courses will take their respective examination.

On testing days, students will arrive and depart school at the regular time. On each of these days there will be an examination period and consequent rotation of classes (our schedule is below). For each day, students who are NOT testing will arrive at school at the normal time and will report to the gymnasium or

the student center. Otherwise, non-test-takers can opt to arrive for their class by 8:33 via their own transportation.
