Dear Students, Families, and Staff,

We would like to thank everyone who came to the most recent Board of Education meeting, and after careful review and consideration of the points raised that evening, the Administration has determined the following will occur.

Any student who receives a failing grade between 30 and 69 on a test (excluding quarterlies) may request of their teacher to retake that test. The retake will be given within three days of receiving the original test and will take place after school or at a time designated by the teacher. The maximum possible score for a test retake will be a 70.

As stated in Mr. Claeys' letter of November 9, 2016, future quarterlies will count as two test grades and will be posted at the outset to the following marking period.

The Lenape Valley Up-Grade Annex program will continue to be offered in the third marking period. Courses will be offered in all subject areas and will run based on the number of subscriptions.

For those who may need extra help, the faculty at Lenape Valley Regional High School is happy to assist students. Also, our National Honor Society chapter will continue to hold daily tutoring sessions.
